This leaflet is aimed at our members in the Commercial Sector and encourages you to take part in the forthcoming elections to the PCS National Executive Committee (NEC). Who you elect to the NEC is important and helps to determine the leadership and direction of our union.

Our members face incredible attacks on our living standards from employers intent on job cuts and pay freezes and a government who is doing everything to side with the millionaire bosses at the expense of the millions of workers in this country.

It is crucial that our union leadership is made up of members who have a proven track record of delivering for members interests and organising our union into the campaigning force that it is today. It will be a disaster if we allow our union to fall back into the hands of the right wing union leaders who used to control our union for their own interests and the interests of the employer.

We want to ensure that we build a commercial sector part of our union that is democratic and member led and where the issues that matter to members - a living wage, pay transparency, pay progression, job security, defending pensions and access to decent pensions for all - are the priority for our union.

In the last 12 months, we have seen significant disputes involving workers in the private sector. In Hewlett Packard, members voted to take 7 days of strike action to win better pay and to win collective bargaining for PCS members working on the DWP account. In Capita Filestores, members voted to strike in support of a claim for a living wage and ran a campaign that included direct action picketing of the Capita HQ that generated national media attention.

Over the next 12 months, PCS members working in the private sector will face unprecedented threats to their jobs with many employers trying to make compulsory redundancies on statutory minimum redundancy terms.

Rich multinationals will attempt to impose pay freezes on workers barely earning the minimum wage. Our pensions are under attack and we have too many members who already can't afford to be members of their pension scheme. Our communities will be ravaged by the coalition governments agenda of cuts.

If you believe we need a commercial sector that is on the side of members and that has the strategy, energy and commitment to resist the bosses agenda and can build a fighting, campaigning and vibrant union that wins for members then please vote for the Democracy Alliance candidates overleaf.

The Democracy Alliance will continue to build a strong effective and democratic union we can all be proud of.
